**CONNECT** - Cooperation and training on innovation and entrepreneurship in the eHealth community is an Erasmus+ project designed to foster cooperation and skills in health innovation, through a multidisciplinary training for higher education students.

#### What do we want to create?

The eHealth market is growing exponentially, and anyone wanting to work in this domain needs up-to-date information. There is a lack of curriculum for this area of study, and a dire need for specialists.

Our project addresses actions that promote innovative pedagogies and methods for teaching, learning, and assessment and supports educators and learners to use digital technologies in creative, collaborative, and efficient ways. These resources will significantly impact active learning through peer-to-peer and mentor-to-mentee learning, collaboration, managing teaching, and learning experiences.

A curriculum centered around theoretical and practical subjects within the eHealth domain was developed as an online book, which will be adapted as an interactive online resource, and soon to be available on the eHealth Community of Practice platform for managing eHealth eLearning. It will be addressed to individuals with a background in health care, information technology and computer science, social sciences, marketing, management or entrepreneurship in digital health.

Our platform will be created as a space where people interested in this domain can learn, find a community, and discuss with others so that they can come up with innovative solutions.

CONNECT also aims to create a bridge between professionals working in this domain so that they can create interdisciplinary networks. The project produced a comprehensive set of resources to support eHealth education, and it will be updated in 2022. If you are interested, stay close to our project development.








## **eHealth Networking Day**
